The 2001 Household SAR is available for England and Wales only. The Household SAR represents a one percent sample of all households drawn from the 2001 Census. It comprises 225436 household records and 525715 individual records. Individual records are available only for households with 11 or fewer residents. Household records include a small number of empty households.

Access

The data is available only under the ONS Special Licence (<http://www.data-archive.ac.uk/orderingdata/specialLicence.asp>). There is no version of the Household SAR available under the usual End User Licence and it is not available direct from CCSR.

The sample

The sample was drawn from the One Number Census database and thus individuals and households imputed as part of the ONC are included. The Household SAR is a stratified simple random sample; more details of the sampling procedure are given in the SARs User Guide at <http://www.ccsr.ac.uk/sars/guide/>. There is no overlap between any of the SAR files. All records have been scrambled before release to ensure they cannot be identified geographically.

The population sampled

The sample excludes those in communal establishments. It includes households with dummy forms and also 'students living-away' who provide very limited individual information because they should be fully enumerated at their usual term-time residence. The variable 'popbase' allows users to identify these categories and select their required population base.

The file was sampled from the 'one-number census' database. This includes data which was imputed for non-respondent individuals or households. Imputed cases can be identified using the oncperim variable.

File structure

The file allows linkage of individuals within families and households using the following identification variables:

Pnum:	person number within household
Famnumb:	Family Indicator
Hhid:	Household indicator

For households of 12 or over, only household level variables are available – there are no individual records.

The variable ID identifies each case uniquely.

Variables

To protect confidentiality age has been grouped into two-year bands and there is no geographical breakdown available. There has been a small amount of perturbation to protect confidentiality.

As with the Individual Licensed SAR, separate variables indicate whether or not imputation or perturbation has been applied to any given variable for each case in the sample. The variables all have the prefix 'z', e.g. 'zageh' indicates whether a respondent's value of ageh was imputed or perturbed.
